Detailed view of the teacher module

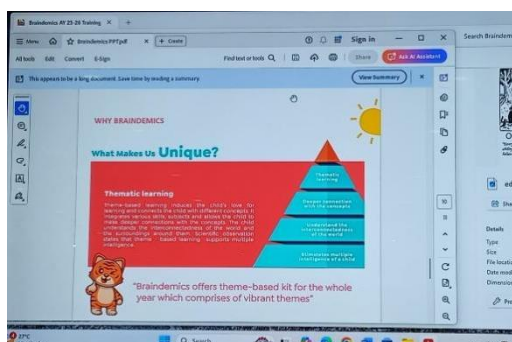
